



Teton Valley's **Rotary Food Bank** at St Francis Church

Who are we?

The Rotary Food Bank of Teton Valley at St Francis Church was formed in November of 2008. The Rotary Club of Teton Valley teamed up with St Francis Church, of Alta Wy, to create the much needed resource. Now, this joint effort oversees the operations of the Food Bank, coordinates volunteers, food drives and so on.

Where does the food come from?

The Food Bank is stocked with food from community donations and food drives, food purchased with monies received from donations and grants, and food purchased from the Idaho Food Bank. The Idaho Food Bank is a non-profit that provides food for a low handling cost.

Details...

The Food Bank is open weekly on Wednesday evenings from 5-7PM at St Francis Church. The Food Bank is open to any low income residents in need of emergency food. Recipients must fill out a short form listing their name, phone number and the ages of the recipients. The Food Bank is intended to be a short-term solution. A guide of local resources is available for recipients.

What is our mission?

The Food Bank's mission is to provide a temporary food source to low income residents of Teton Valley Idaho and Wyoming who are in emergency need of food. The Food Bank's goal is to alleviate hunger in Teton Valley by soliciting and collecting food for distribution to those who are in need.

How are we funded?

The Food Bank receives financial support from the Rotary Club of Teton Valley, charitable organizations, corporate donations, and individual contributions. The Food Bank is completely volunteer and operates financially under St Francis of the Tetons, a 501C3 non-profit. The Food Bank committee actively solicits funding through grant requests and fundraisers. The committee also organizes monthly food drives and solicits canned good donations from the community.
