Earn tax credits on new garage

doors - (ARA) -- The tax credit eligibility for qualified garage doors will expire on Dec. 31. Now is your last chance to save 30 percent off the price of an energy-saving curb-appeal-inspiring garage door, courtesy of the U.S. government.

The savings come from a federal income tax credit. Through the end of this year, the U.S. government is offering up to a \$1,500 tax credit for homeowners who buy and install qualifying insulated garage doors. Full details can be found at GarageWowNow.com, a non-commercial home improvement resource dedicated to garage doors and garage door openers.

A taxpayer may claim a maximum of 30 percent of qualifying home improvement products, and a maximum of \$1,500 for qualifying purchases in 2009 and 2010. For example, if you replace two garage doors with two new qualifying insulated doors that cost \$1,000 each, you may claim a tax credit of \$300 per door, or a total of \$600, provided you have not exceeded the \$1,500 total over the two years of the tax credit period.

Q: What is a title search and title insurance all about?

A: Before closing, a seller's title must be searched to make sure he/she owns marketable title to the property. The buyer has the responsibility of determining whether the seller has a satisfactory marketable title that meets the requirements of the contract. The buyer accomplishes this by retaining and paying an attorney to check the seller's title. The attorney's search will determine if the seller has good record of title through the chain of sales, whether there are any outstanding encumbrances, deeds, contracts, deeds of trust, mortgages, judgments, tax or liens, easements or other defects of title that will prevent the buyer from getting a clear and marketable title at closing.

If title insurance is desired by the purchaser or required by the lender (as it usually is), the attorney submits a preliminary opinion on title to a title insurance company as an application for a policy. The title company then insures the buyer against any future claims on the title of that property. So, for example, a long-lost relative cannot come and say he has a claim to it.
