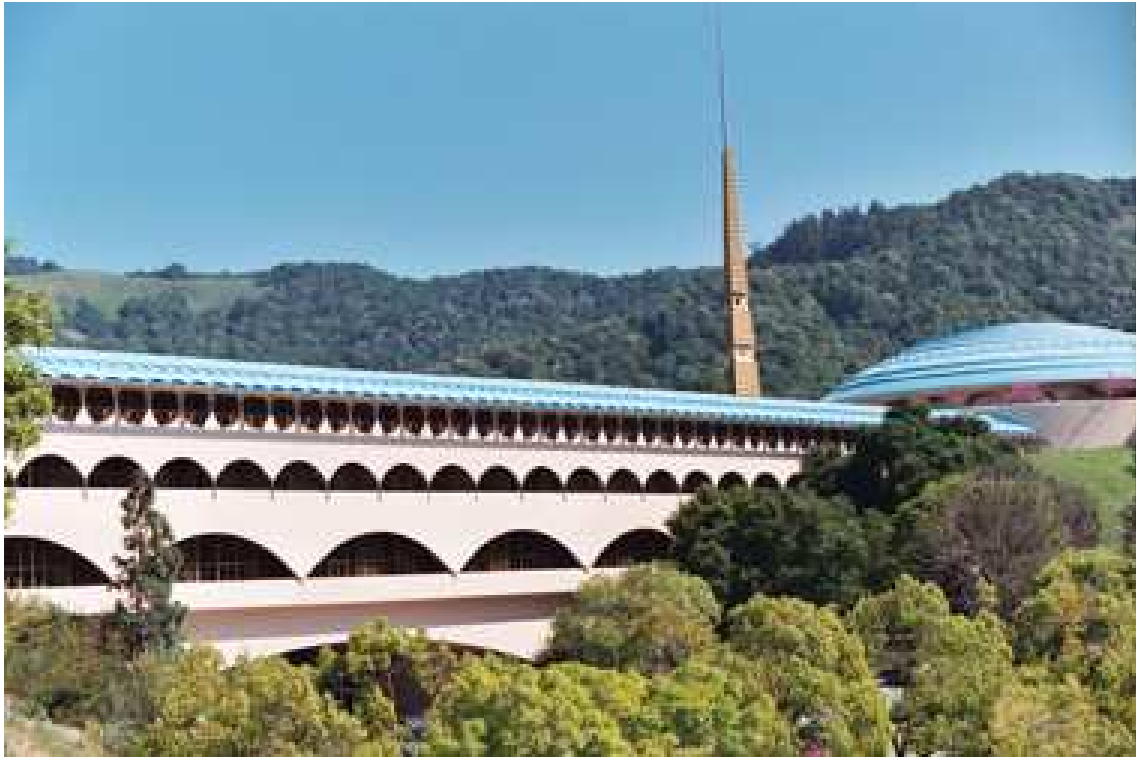

## **Overview**

One of the wealthiest cities in the Bay Area, Belvedere is an appendage off the Tiburon peninsula with incredible views of San Francisco. Belvedere, Italian for “beautiful view,” sticks out far enough to peek around Cavallo Point with a glimpse the Golden Gate Bridge.

## **Points of Interest**

The historic China Cabin, a 19th century seaside saloon, is located in Belvedere. Ferries to Angel Island, as well as San Francisco (known as the “City”), leave from the Tiburon ferry terminal.

## **Weather**

Like neighboring Tiburon, Belvedere sees a lot of fog rolling in from the bay. Being on the water, temperatures are moderate; average temps range from 40-74.

## **Overview**

This bedroom town straddles Highway 101 just above Mill Valley and extends east to the Bay. Called a “shopper’s delight,” Corte Madera is home to two large malls. Besides a 22-acre park with tennis courts and recreation equipment, the town also has a historic village square and several surrounding open space preserves.

## **Points of Interest**

In addition to two malls, Corte Madera is home to many parks that range in size from small neighborhood fields and playgrounds to large areas with tennis and basketball courts, baseball fields, and soccer facilities. The area's commitment to the environment is clear; five preserves border Corte Madera to the South, including Ring Mountain Open Space preserve.

## **Weather**

Corte Madera has an average temperature of around 59 degrees, with an average maximum temperature of 70 degrees and an average low of 48. From July to September, highs get into the 80s. The coldest months are November and December. Mount Tamalpais and Christmas Tree Hill usually protect the town from perpetual fog, but it does get its fair share, especially on summer mornings.

## **Overview**

Friendly, but lively Fairfax is small enough to allow residents to get to know one another. The area is known for its huge Fourth of July picnics and Big Band parties in the 1960s with crowds of party-happy, tie-dyed hipsters, some of whom still remain. Fairfax is an ideal spot for outdoor lovers. Residents & visitors bike and climb its hills, and picnic at local lakes and other forested watershed lands on the slopes of Mt. Tamalpais.

## **Points of Interest**

Fairfax is not a big shopping town, but has quaint shops lining Broadway, including variety stores, boutiques, and grocery stores. The evening entertainment scene is really happening, with restaurants & bars featuring live music as well as a movie theater along the same stretch in downtown. Mt. Tamalpais along with several open space preserves with hiking trails are just a short drive away.

## **Weather**

Average temperature is 59 degrees, with an average maximum temperature of 70 degrees and an average low of 48. From July to September, highs get into the 80s. Fairfax doesn't get much fog, and being inland, it tends to be hotter in the summer than other communities closer to the coast.

## Overview

Among Greenbrae's many attributes are gracious homes, stunning views, wooded neighborhoods and good schools. Many of the homes have view of Mt. Tamalpais, the bay, Corte Madera Creek and the lowlands. Hiking trails, parks and recreation are in neighboring Larkspur or just over the hill in San Rafael. Being close to the freeway and Larkspur ferry makes this community a good commute to and from the City.

## Points of Interest

Greenbrae has one main park and several nearby hiking and biking trails and Mt. Tamalpais and Muir Woods are easily accessed from Highway 101. Aside from the shops and businesses at Bon Air Shopping Center, there's plenty of shopping and dining opportunities at nearby Larkspur Landing. Greenbrae is also home of Marin General Hospital, the county's largest medical facility.

Greenbrae doesn't get too much fog, and since it is inland it tends to be hotter in the summer than other communities closer to the coast.

# Kentfield

(Unincorporated Area)



## Overview

Kentfield is an upper middle class to wealthy neighborhood located in the hills between Larkspur, San Rafael and Ross. The majority of homes are set back from roads among pine, redwood and manzanita trees. With few sidewalks, and meandering streets the wooded areas of Kentfield create a warm “country feeling.”

The majority of the city services are provided by the City of Larkspur and the County of Marin.

## Points of Interest

The College of Marin in Kentfield offers courses that appeal to many adults and opens its pool to the public. The Bon Air shopping center in nearby Greenbrae offers a number of shops and Larkspur Landing provides an array of shopping and dining opportunities. Kentfield is close to Mt. Tamalpais, with miles of hiking and biking trails, and also has quick access to the many parks located throughout Marin County.

## Weather

Average temperature is 59 degrees, with an average maximum temperature of 71 degrees and an average low of 48. Because of its location, Kentfield gets more rain than most other Marin towns with an average annual rainfall of almost 50 inches.

## Overview

Larkspur has a very charming and quaint downtown. Most of the town lies inland, but the part that fronts the water is home to the county's largest ferry terminal, as well as a huge metal sculpture of Sir Francis Drake.

Larkspur presents very special places to play, to relax, to shop, to dine and to enjoy many of the loveliest things Marin County has to offer. There are world-renowned restaurants, stylish stores, intimate coffee houses and unique shopping centers. There are lush redwood

groves, winding trails and waterways, a boardwalk where people live suspended above water and rock formations where Miwok Indians held celebrations for nearly two thousand years.



## Points of Interest

Besides several tiny neighborhood parks, Larkspur has one large park with ball fields, playground, tennis courts, and other sports facilities. Larkspur is home to a variety of restaurants and two movie theaters, as well as a shopping plaza. A short car ride puts Mt. Tam, the Sausalito Waterfront and the ferry to Angel Island in easy reach.

## Overview

Mill Valley was named after a lumber mill, which was later rebuilt to keep the past alive. After the 1906 earthquake, Mill Valley residents helped rebuild San Francisco and some people fled San Francisco in belief that Mill Valley was less prone to earthquakes.



Quaint downtown, restaurants, delis, coffee shops, clothing stores, bookstores, a theater, art gallery, antique stores and a small inn lodge with a street layout give Mill Valley a “village square” feeling. For those with an artistic bent, there's a noted film festival every fall, as well as an outdoor arts fair, festival of wine and Memorial Day crafts festival in Bayfront Park.

## Points of Interest

Located at the base of Mt. Tam and the edge of Muir Woods, Mill Valley boasts some of the finest in outdoor opportunities on the parks' hiking and biking trails. Stinson Beach and Golden Gate National Recreation Area are also nearby. Within Mill Valley's borders, there are numerous shops and restaurants, several smaller parks, a movie theatre, nightspots, and a range of annual events.

## Weather

When Mount Tamalpais blocks fog from rolling into central Marin, this is where it ends up, but it usually burns off by early afternoon. Mill Valley is near the bay, so is cooler than its inland neighbors, with average temperatures ranging from 40 to 74.

## Overview

The second most populous city in the county next to San Rafael, and one of the few that is adding, by Marin standards, a great many people, thanks to the development of the former Hamilton Air Force Base. Novato has a rural atmosphere largely because of its low population density and the high amount of open space and parks in and near the city.

Major community events include the Novato Festival of Art, Wine and Music each June, Concerts in the Park throughout the summer, the annual 4th of July Parade in downtown Novato and the City's Labor Day Picnic at Stafford Lake.

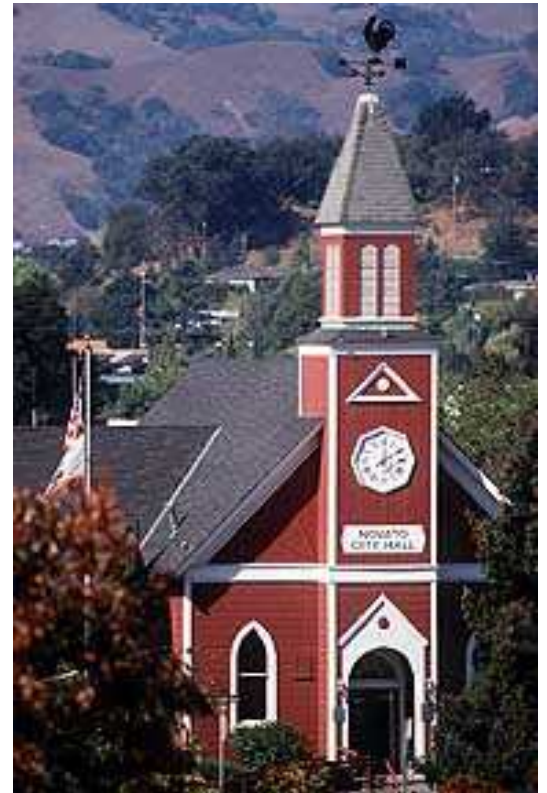
In recent history, Novato's latest additions include Fireman's Fund headquarters, the county's largest employer; the huge Vintage Oaks shopping mall; Hamilton Field; and the Buck Center Research in Aging.

## Points of Interest

Olompali State Historical Park, where Miwok Indians traded in 500 A.D. and the Grateful Dead got back to nature in the 60s, has great hiking trails and is a few miles north on U.S. 101. There is a 139-acre park just west of the city with a nature trail, softball, volleyball and fishing (on the park's Stafford Lake). And, with a population of 49,000, Novato has a wealth of restaurants, stores and services available.

## Weather

Novato is in the county's northern region. It's also the hottest area. Its yearly average temperature is 58 degrees, and its average temperature range is between 46 and 67 degrees. July through August are the hottest months, with an average high of 78 degrees, but it occasionally reaches into the 90s. It has an average humidity of 60 percent and gets about 26.3 inches of rainfall per year, usually between November and April.

## Overview

San Rafael became Marin's first city in 1874 and its roots can be traced to December 1817, when Spanish Franciscans founded Mission San Rafael Archangel at the foot of San Rafael Hill, the 20th of California's 21 missions.

More than 56,000 residents make their home in the county seat, the commercial, cultural and governmental center of Marin. Just 17 miles north of San Francisco and surrounded by wooded, grassy hillsides and the bay, about one-third of the city's 17 square miles is open space. East of the Marin County Civic Center, Frank Lloyd Wright's architectural enigma, is China Camp State Park, a former shrimp fishing village that now offers recreational opportunities, as does the nearby McNear's Beach Park. But the heart of the city lies west of Highway 101, where scores of retail shops and restaurants line downtown streets.

## Points of Interest

In addition to county offices, the Marin Civic Center contains the 2000-seat War Memorial Veterans Auditorium, which regularly schedules concerts and performances. Recent headliners include the Chieftains, the Boys Choir of Harlem and Willie Nelson.

Mission San Rafael Archangel (the present building is a replica of the original mission, which was built in 1817) stands as testament to the state's rich Spanish past. There's also hiking, swimming and boating at China Camp and 441 acres of John F. McInnis Park to canoe, play in or golf.
